# TIMELINE OF HIGH SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

- Draft of final application with 12 choices is due November 12th
- Draft must be APPROVED by me.
- Once approved:  
Final Application Due: December 15th
- Receive Results - Spring

# SHSAT Dates

- SHSAT Registration Deadline is Tuesday, November 2nd
- Specialized High School Admissions Test
  - Only way to apply to 8 specialized high schools in NYC
  - HIGHLY competitive - only take test if you have been prepping for the test through the summer and your grades are 85+.
- Must register for the SHSAT through me
- Form has been given out (if you need one, please ask your child to ask me for it or send me a TP)
- SHSAT Dates  
Dec. 5th or Dec. 11th

# Fechas SHSAT

- La fecha límite para inscribirse en SHSAT es el Martes 2 de Noviembre
- Prueba de ingreso a la escuela secundaria especializada
  - Única forma de postularse a 8 escuelas secundarias especializadas en Nueva York
  - ALTAMENTE competitivo: solo tome el examen si se ha estado preparando para el examen durante el verano y sus calificaciones son de 85+.
- Debe registrarse para el SHSAT a través de mí
- Se ha entregado el formulario (si lo necesita, pídale a su hijo/a que me lo pida o envíeme un TP)
- Fechas SHSAT  
5 o 11 de Diciembre



# Do's and Don'ts for MySchools use

## Do:

1. Use myschools to research high schools
2. Find graduation rate, college enrollment rate, safety rating
3. Find programs that each HS offers
4. Find location and website of different high schools

## Don't:

1. Create an account
2. Apply to HS on your own, I still have to do the *final* submission
  - a. **EXTREMELY** easy to make mistakes and end up applying to the wrong school and then you are stuck.
3. Listen when a high school tells you that you **MUST** apply early through myschools. They are lying and trying to rush you to apply to their school. It is a way that they look better by getting more students to apply to their school.

# Qué hacer y qué no hacer para el uso de MySchools

## Hacer:

1. Utilice myschools para investigar las escuelas secundarias
2. Encuentre el porcentaje de graduación, el porcentaje de matrícula universitaria, la clasificación de seguridad
3. Encuentre los programas que ofrece cada HS
4. Encuentra ubicación y sitio web de diferentes escuelas secundarias

## No hacer:

1. Crea una cuenta
2. Postúlate a HS por tu cuenta, todavía tengo que hacer la presentación final
  - a. EXTREMADAMENTE fácil cometer errores y terminar aplicando a la escuela equivocada y luego estás estancado.
3. Escuche cuando una escuela secundaria le diga que DEBE aplicar temprano a través de mis escuelas. Mienten y tratan de apresurarte para que postules a su escuela. Es una manera de que se vean mejor al lograr que más estudiantes se postulen para su escuela

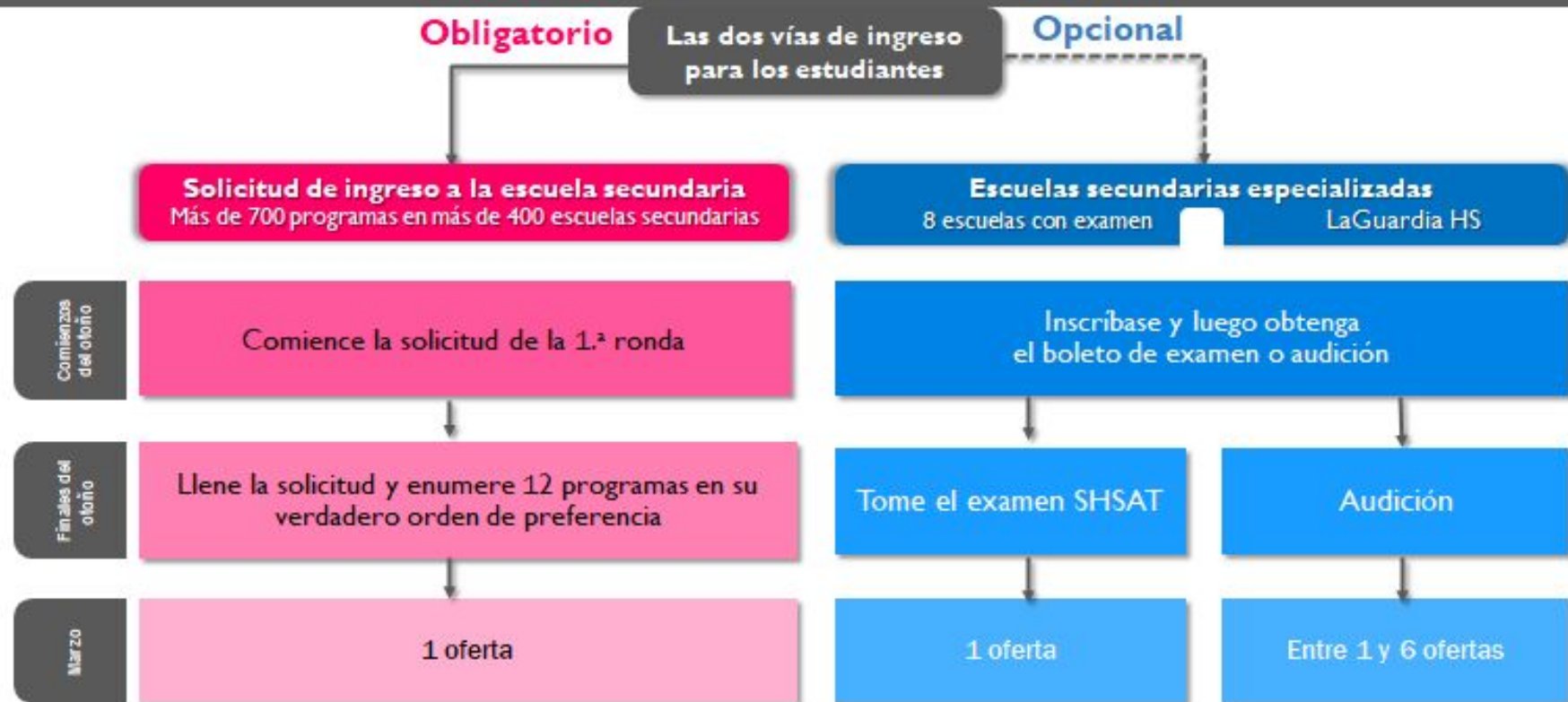

# HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS

## Programs and Admissions Methods

- You can think about programs as “doorways” through which they accept students.
- If a school has multiple programs, eligible students may apply to one program, or more than one program at that school.

There are 5 ways that offers are determined

- This is the order in which offers are determined:
  1. Choices on the Application
  2. Admissions Priorities
  3. Eligibility
  4. Seat Availability
  5. Admissions Methods

# HOW OFFERS ARE DETERMINED

## CHOICES ON THE APPLICATION

- **Students should list 12 programs on their application.** Listing fewer than 12 works against a student; making it less likely to receive an offer from the application.
- **Students should list programs in their true order of preference starting with their top choice.** High Schools will not see where families rank them. High Schools should not ask where they've been ranked, or insist on ranking them first.
- Students are considered for offers in the order of the programs on their application.
- If you don't get into your first choice, then you are considered for the next choice. It's as though the next choice is your new first choice.

**98% of students who listed 12 programs received an offer in Round 1!**

# CÓMO SE DETERMINAN LAS OFERTAS

## OPCIONES EN LA SOLICITUD

- Los estudiantes deben incluir 12 programas en su solicitud. Enumerar menos de 12 opciones trabaja en contra de un estudiante; por lo que es menos probable que reciba una oferta de la aplicación.
- Los estudiantes deben enumerar los programas en su verdadero orden de preferencia, comenzando con su primera opción. Las escuelas secundarias no verán dónde las clasifican las familias. Las escuelas secundarias no deben preguntar dónde se han clasificado ni insistir en clasificarlas en primer lugar.
- Los estudiantes son considerados para ofertas en el orden de los programas en su solicitud.
- Si no entra en su primera opción, entonces está considerado para la siguiente elección. Es como si la siguiente opción fuera tu nueva primera opción.

¡El 98% de los estudiantes que enumeraron 12 programas recibieron una oferta en la Ronda 1!
